It is with great pleasure that Burlingame Community for Education Foundation (BCE) presents \$3,035,000 to Burlingame School District (BSD) for use during the 2025-2026 school year. This unrestricted grant demonstrates the commitment of parents and community to BCE's mission, our school district, and its students. The money will be allocated to the following programs based upon goals established by the BSD School Board of Trustees and allocated by BSD Administration in accordance with BSD's financial needs.

This grant supplements the amount BSD receives from the State of California, local parcel taxes, and federal funds.

We recognize that costs in a category can shift within a school year. As such, BCE's Board of Directors authorizes BSD to shift funds across BCE-supported categories in those situations in which a given category ends up with a reserve and another category has a shortfall. In all cases, if BSD spends more in total for BCE-supported categories during the school year than is granted by BCE, the extra amount spent is the responsibility of BSD. Furthermore, if the combined cost of all BCE-supported programs falls below the total amount granted by BCE for the current school year, then funds that are not spent will be

reallocated in collaboration with the BCE Board of Directors.

BSD Administration will provide a grant allocation status report to BCE and donors at regular interim budget updates during the school year.

BCE's grant intends to support programs available equally to students across BSD. Funding for all programs is for the current school year and does not guarantee full funding of such programs in future years.

We are proud of the partnership that exists between Burlingame School District and the Burlingame community. We are also deeply grateful to our donors and volunteers who made this grant possible for the benefit of our children.
